

Salida Community Center's will be holding a food distribution on March Wednesday 3, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. at 305 F. Street at the Community Center.

The Salida Community Center will be handling the TEFAP program administered by Care and Share out of Colorado Springs. TEFAP stands for The Emergency Food Assistance Program and is a federal program that provides people living on a low income with extra food each month at NO COST!!
