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Chaffee County Public Health Urges Community Participation in Final Days of Access to Healthcare Survey

Chaffee County, CO – Chaffee County Public Health (CCPH) is making a final appeal to all residents to participate in the Access to Healthcare Survey before it closes on July 31, 2024. Launched on May 15, this comprehensive survey aims to gather essential data on the strengths, needs, and opportunities for enhancing health and wellness throughout Chaffee County.

Many residents have already taken the survey, and based on the initial data gathered, CCPH believes there will be significant insights that all healthcare sectors can use to better serve the public. However, with just a few weeks remaining, CCPH emphasizes the importance of capturing a comprehensive view from as many residents as possible. In particular, this survey is missing the voices of the Spanish speaking community, individuals ages 18-24 and men.

“We want to ensure that every voice is heard,” said Andrea Carlstrom, Director of CCPH. “The feedback from this survey will guide us in making informed decisions and implementing effective strategies to enhance healthcare services for all. Please take the survey, and encourage your friends and neighbors to do so as well.”
