NEW Community Pulse Survey

NEW Amended Public Health Order

On August 4th, the <u>Chaffee County Amended Public Health Order</u> was updated. As you review this order, you will see much of it is now aligned with the latest State's Public Health Order.

NEW CCPH is Hiring

The Chaffee County BOCC is accepting applications for a part-time 20 hr/wk nurse to work in the Public Health Department with the COVID-19 program. Under the direct supervision and

guidance of the Public Health Director, with support from the internal COVID-19 team, the COVID-19 Public Health Nurse is responsible for participating in the COVID-19 efforts including testing (set-up, day of activities at the testing site, and results follow-up), contact tracing, and education and outreach. Minimum requirements include High School diploma or equivalent, Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing preferred, Associate Degree in Nursing with extensive public health nursing experience will be considered; experience with Microsoft Outlook, Word, Excel and PowerPoint. Funding for this position runs approximately 28 months; flexible hours from Friday thru Monday and other days as needed. Starting annual salary is \$31,200 (\$30 per hour); benefits include participation in the County's retirement plan and prorated holidays and leave time. NEW Community Testing Clinics in Salida and BV

Chaffee County Public Health, in collaboration with Chaffee County EMS, hosts free COVID-19 Community Testing Clinic weekly. Tuesdays and Thursdays are held in Salida at the Touber Building from 9:30-11 and Wednesdays in Buena Vista from 9-11am at 114 Linderman Avenue. *Testing is by appointment only*. Appointments must be scheduled by close of business the day before the testing clinic will be held. Criteria for testing includes:

- Any community member (or others who consider Chaffee County their medical home)
 who is showing symptoms
- Any asymptomatic patient who has a known contact (within 6 feet, greater than 15 minutes) with a positive case or has traveled in an area with high rates of transmission.
 This does not include secondary contacts.
- All healthcare workers, first responders, senior care facility workers, and essential
 workers who directly interact with the public while working, whether or not those
 individuals have symptoms or not.

If you are interested in testing, call Public Health at 719-539-4510 to be screened and scheduled for testing. Those with severe respiratory symptoms should contact their primary care provider directly.
